

VIRTUAL INTERNSHIPS IN INDIA / NEPAL

With the Covid-19 pandemic restricting travel to the Indian Sub-continent for real-time internships with NGOs, we are pleased to offer you some exciting possibilities for **Virtual Internships**. Each of these internships have been carefully planned and will have a qualified Mentor who will interact with the student over the duration of the internship. On completion of the program and after assessment, the student will be given a **"Certificate of Participation"**, which will be of value when applying for further education or seeking employment. Though these internships do not have any transfer of credits, your Faculty Advisor may be able to suggest complementary courses at your own university that might give you the necessary credit hours.

Students applying for any of these Virtual Internships will be assessed by the Mentor to ensure that expectations and interests are aligned, prior to acceptance. The Internships will run over a period of **6 weeks**, during which time there will be a **weekly on-line interaction with the Mentor for 1-1½ hrs.** In addition, students are expected to work about **6-8 hrs per week on research and written work**. If the student desires to come to India or Nepal next year, when the situation is conducive, at his/her own expense, to intern with the NGO, this will be facilitated.

Internships are a great way to build skills while creating meaningful impact in the world.

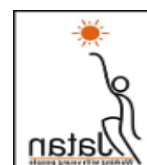
1: Incentive Foundation – Bandhwari Women's Empowerment Project, Gurgaon



Incentive Foundation was formed as the CSR outreach of *Inspiration India*, with a vision to empower sustainable change among the less advantaged, through education and self-help, thereby building a more equitable society. The Foundation has been involved with the urban village of Bandhwari in Gurgaon (near Delhi) since March 2005. Over the years, the Bandhwari Women's Empowerment Project has helped many women break out of the traditional roles set out for them. The training provided in making fabric-based products has helped them earn a supplementary income for the family, while providing a community facility at the Women's Centre set up by the Foundation.
